From the 13<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup> of October, 2023 The Jury of the Kazimierz Serocki 18<sup>th</sup> International Composers' Competition 2023 took place.

85 (eighty-five) scores were sent to the Competition from all over the world.

The Jury: Paweł Łukaszewski (Poland), Paul Patterson (United Kingdom), and Dariusz Przybylski (Poland) decided to give the following prizes:

The FIRST Prize (13.000PLN) went to **Masato Kimura** (JAPAN) – – ~ *minus* ~ VII  
< *Picture Book of Mist* > for string quartet.

The SECOND Prize (8.000PLN) went to **Luca Vago** (ITALY) – *Encendiendo* for piano quartet.

The THIRD Prize (4.000PLN) went to **Uri Brener** (ISRAEL) – *The Flow* for piano trio.

The prizes were funded by **The Ministry of Culture and National Heritage**.
